The Bible passes the test.

There are more controversial statements made by men about the Bible than any other book in history. All the Christian based churches say they believe the bible EXCEPT for such - n - such. All that has been accomplished with these new translations is nobody agrees anymore when they have a bible study or discussion. 1Corinthians 2:13-16 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

14* But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

15* But he that is spiritual (God) judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

16* For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ. (with the Holy Spirit)
You have to ask God, the author of the scriptures, for the understanding.

One of the biggest arguments from dead churches is: "The bible was written by man and thus open to mistakes". WRONG, God used man to write it, BUT under His anointing.

2Timothy 3:16* All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

Luke 21:33 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.

You see, under the law the commandments were written on stone, circumcision is an outward action as well. Under the new dispensation of Grace (through Christ) God has written the commandments on our heart and thus we are circumcised in heart.

Romans 2:29* But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is

not of men, but of God.

2Corinthians 3:3* Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart.

If a person has had a TRUE conversion to Christ it can't help but show outwardly.

2Corinthians 5:17* Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new

In other words if you were a crook, you no longer want to steal. If you were a Liar you no longer want to lie.

Galatians 5:19* Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,

20* Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,

21* Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. So you can profess Christianity but if you haven't changed or make excuses why the bible isn't accurate, then YOU DON"T KNOW CHRIST or are you known of him.

The Bible Contains 66 books, written by 40 different authors, over 1500 years, in 3 different languages, on 3 different continents, with no historical errors or contradictions. The entire Bible, from Genesis to Revelation, bears the mark of divine inspiration.

It is written by 64 Jewish and in the new testament 2 gentiles Which equal 66 books

If it is HISTORICALLY correct over all these years with different authors and languages, DON"T YOU THINK the spiritual aspect is correct as well ????
