

Why did Jesus go to the Cross

#146

Isaiah 53:5* **But he was wounded for our transgressions,
he was bruised for our iniquities:
the chastisement of our peace was upon him;
and with his stripes we are healed.**

transgressions

infringe or go beyond the bounds of - principle or other
established standard , broken or not kept: **Gods Law (Sin)**
Jesus took all of mankind's sins upon himself.

Past, Present and Future - ALL

It requires belief in Jesus

=====

iniquity

immoral or gross behavior -- To transgress knowingly
**This is after we have come to know Jesus as our savior, it
requires asking forgiveness.**

=====

chastisement --- rebuke or reprimand severely -
punishment:

**Jesus was punished severely so that we have Peace --
No Stress**

=====

healed

a person or a wound, or injury, to become sound or healthy
again: Restored to new:

**Jesus paid the price and took upon himself EVERY
Diseases or Sickness That ever WAS or SHALL BE at
Calvary's Cross.**

=====

**In answer to your question, you already know that
mankind is born in Sin through the fall of Adam and Eve.**

People lived under the grace of God but had no guidelines as to HOW to live until Moses and the Law.

Romans 7:8* But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin was dead.

When God brought the Law, sin was not taken away but only covered by the blood of animals.

Hebrews 9:22* And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

The law brought condemnation and self righteousness

Luke 18:11 The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

Romans 8:1* There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

When Jesus came and went to the cross, he was the only person that fulfilled the Law perfectly and was able to pay the price with his shed blood to redeem us to fellowship with God the father just like Adam and Eve had before they sinned. We went from the law to the Grace of God THROUGH faith in Jesus the Christ.

Ephesians 2:8* For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

You see, GRACE is what God HAS provided (everything Christ died for on the Cross of Calvary) Faith or Trust is what We do to appropriate or receive what Jesus HAS already given us.

You don't beg God for something he has already given us.

Matthew 21:21* Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I

say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, **ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.**

All faith is TRUST, you trust what God says or you don't, NO IN BETWEEN. Flues, colds, stress or any kind of sickness was redeemed at the Cross, it's a done deal just trust God and his word. You have the authority and mind of Christ, USE IT.

Do you trust what your five natural senses say OR do you trust what your spiritual senses tell you ?

Matthew 11:28-30* **Come unto me**, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and **ye shall find rest** unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
