

Grace V/S Law

Jesus Christ is the way the truth and the life, and no man cometh unto the father but through him.

John 14:6* Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

John 10:9* I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

Acts 4:12* Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Jesus shed his blood so that everybody (Jew or Gentile) has All their sins washed away and forgiven and ALL THEY HAVE TO DO is BELIEVE in Jesus. (not on Jesus)

Ephesians 2:8* For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

Romans 5:15* But not as the offence, so also is the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.

John 3:36* He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

John 12:44* Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me.

1John 5:10* He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.

The old law only covered your sins by the blood of bulls, sheep and goats was fulfilled through the shedding of the

righteous blood of Jesus the Son of the Living God, once and for ALL. There is no more or any other way to obtain forgiveness of sins.

John 1:17* For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 10:4* For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

Romans 6:14* For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

Romans 6:15 What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.

Galatians 5:18* But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

Romans 2: 29* But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.

The old Leviticus law was written on stone and parchment
The law since Christ is written on our hearts.

Jeremiah 31:33* But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.
The old law read "THOU SHALT NOT" The Heart law if readable would say "I WILL NOT"

Jesus paid a double price for all our Sins, Sickness, Diseases, Joy, Comfort and any other thing that may come upon you.

Isaiah 40:2* Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her iniquity is pardoned: for she hath received of the LORD'S hand double for all her sins.

Psalms 103:2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

4 Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies;

5* Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Isaiah 53:5-8 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

6* All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

7* He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

8* He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

Remember -

The Elect - is Israelites that have not excepted Jesus Blood.

The Gentile - is non jews that have not excepted Christ.

The Church - is Jew and Gentile that have excepted Christ.

Colossians 3:11* Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all.
