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Question: where did the sin or evil come from?

John 1:3* All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. (the key here is was made)

Rebellion and submission is a choice, Men and angels have a choice to serve God. The Lord wants creation to willingly serve him, If there would be no choice, would you want to live like that. There would be no satisfaction nor self gratitude within you, if you knew others had no choice but to worship you.

Genesis 2:8-9* And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed.

And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil. You notice, HE made the tree of the knowledge of GOOD and EVIL to grow.

(this God created so man would have a choice, if they would have obeyed God, they could of partook of the tree of life just like we will that have obeyed God and put on Christ)

God new what Good and Evil is and man, eating of the fruit of it, his understanding was opened and he knew as well. But the difference is man cannot always choose good, he needs the Spirit of God to do that.

Genesis 2:17* But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Genesis 3:5* For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil

Genesis 3:22* And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for

ever:

Genesis 3:24* **So he drove out the man;** and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.

True every good gift and every perfect gift is from above,
James 1:17* Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning. (the key is good GIFT)
(Sin or disobedience is not a gift but rebellion)

Isaiah 14:12-15 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:

I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.
(Satan chose to rebel against God and so did the third part of the angels that followed him)

Some scriptures on choosing.

Isaiah 56:4* For thus saith the LORD unto the eunuchs that keep my sabbaths, and choose the things that please me, and take hold of my covenant;

Isaiah 65:12* Therefore will I number you to the sword, and ye shall all bow down to the slaughter: because when I called, ye did not answer; when I spake, ye did not hear; but did evil before mine eyes, and did choose that wherein I delighted not.

Jude 6* And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

2Peter 2:4* For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

If angels were zombie's they could only do what their told, but they had to choose between serving God, or following Lucifer. WE have the SAME choice.!!!

2Peter 1:4* Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these **ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.**

The divine nature is to is to always choose good and walk in the victory of Christ.

The only biblical reference for an exception and not be held accountable for our choices i. A CHILD from birth to the age of accountability.

Isaiah 7:16* For before the child shall know to refuse the evil, and choose the good,
