#199 Why do people pray, not my will but thine.

This is a simple question to answer !! Because religion has taught this or it's a man made doctrine.

Jesus never taught this, he did how ever say this ONCE in <u>Luke 22:42</u>* Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done. NOTE: He knew the will of God, that he would take the SINS of the world upon himself and be separated and rejected from the Father and it was just a hope beyond hope there might be another way. Even when he knew there wasn't.

Here are some scriptures **TELLING** you what the will of God is for you.

<u>Romans 8:27</u>* And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God. (third attribute of the Holy Spirit) <u>Romans 12:2</u>* And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. (1 corinthians 2:11-16)

<u>Galatians 1:4</u>* Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, (<u>Romans 12:2</u>*) <u>1Thessalonians 4:3</u>* For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication:

<u>1Thessalonians 5:18</u>* In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. (Not for, but in the situation) <u>1Peter 2:15</u>* For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:

<u>1Corinthians 7:7</u>* For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that.

Isaiah 53:5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was

bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. <u>1Peter 2:24</u>* Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. <u>John 14:13</u>* And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. (anything) <u>1John 5:15</u>* And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

These are just some of the many many scriptures telling us what Gods will is for us. BUT you MUST believe the scriptures. <u>Matthew 21:22</u>* And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

<u>Hebrews 4:16</u>^{*} Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

<u>Isaiah 45:11</u> Thus saith the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me.

<u>Matthew 18:18</u>* Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

In Isaiah it is not a misprint (command me) we have power in Jesus name

<u>Luke 9:1</u>* Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

<u>Acts 1:8</u>* But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: (Not IN you) and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. <u>Mark 16:15-20*</u> And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.

And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

The lord also tells us to put on the WHOLE armour of God in <u>Ephesians 6:11</u>. This is for our protection against Satan.

<u>Romans 14:10</u>* But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.
