

IS THERE A REAL HELL ?

The Lord does tell us, there are one of two places where we will spend eternity. Our spirit and Soul are eternal, so God has prepared a place for us.

For those that reject Jesus and his blood he shed for mankind's redemption. Matthew 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

For those that repent and except Jesus as our Lord and Saviour. Matthew 25:34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

The bible mentions Hell, Hell fire and the Lake of fire 63 times, so I definitely believe it is true and a real place. The bible says that without faith it is impossible to please God. Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. I have heard and read several testimonies from people that Jesus had transported them to Hell, to experience and hear the screams and torment in Hell. Everyone I heard had basically the same tale to tell.

They had a spiritual body, but could feel the fire burning them yet no one was consumed. The demons would beat them and they could feel every blow. Some demons had spears and such and would run them through, the pain was excruciating but there were no marks and you could not die or escape the torment. On top of all this, your mind and memory were totally intact, there is no alzymer's there, you remember every chance you had to repent and except Jesus and his blood atonement. The demons also remind you and tell you how stupid you were to believe them. There are different levels and each level is for those that receive greater punishment. Ones that have known Jesus and forsook him for their own reasons receive more severe torment. The smell is sewer, sulfur and burning and rotting flesh, a total sickening smell with no let up. The air is also so hot it burns your throat and lungs with no stopping, and there is no water there, not even a drop. Luke 16:22-25 And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. **And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.** But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.
