## *What is my Job*

give them to Jesus as quick as possible and receive HIS inner peace. If we harbor them, we then OPEN the door for the forces of evil to afflict us. You see, The devil can DO NOTHING TO US without OUR permission and when we harbor resentments and the such, we are in essence giving him permission.

**James 1:15\*** *Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.*

### **Our armour is listed in Ephesians 6: 13–18**

*13\** Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

*14\** Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with **truth**, and having on the breastplate of **righteousness**; (**his righteousness**)

*15\** And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of **peace**;

*16\** Above all, taking the **shield of faith**, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

*17\** And take the **helmet of salvation**, and the **sword of the Spirit**, *which is the word of God*:

*18\** Praying always **with all prayer** and supplication in the **Spirit**, (**tongues**) and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

**Eph 4:26\*** **Be ye angry**, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:

**this does not mean, make up before you go to bed, the anger here is talking about the anger Jesus showed against Satan. We are never supposed to let the sun go down against the anger we have against sin. In spite of the religious teaching that its OK to be angry with your fellow man as long as you don't go to bed angry. Satan loves it when you believe this garbage.**

The human brain is bent into 2 parts...fight or flight. I have always fought instinctively.....before I even know what I am fighting. I AM a warrior, **This is the old carnal nature talking and not the new nature**

**2Cor 5:17\*** *Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.*

**Rom 12:2\*** *And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.*

**In other words, our old sinful nature is dead and at water baptism we buried it; just like Jesus was buried. The only problem is that we retain a residual old body in our mind, and we want to resurrect it.
