You ask why I always talk about the rapture, denominations and being right with God. It is my calling, as John was called to Baptize and proclaim the soon coming of the kingdom of God. So I feel compelled to warn people (along with others) of not being so wrapped up in their Denominational teachings that they will miss the Rapture, which means one will have to go through the great tribulation.

Revelation 13:17* And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

If one will not believe the bible now, what makes them think they will, when they either have to starve or be beheaded for their stand for Christ.

Revelation 20:4* And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

I personally hope that all will see where they erred and stand for Jesus. BUT to be realistic, there might be a few professing Christians that will stand. The majority though, could not stand for Christ now, when they may only get laughed at, yet they will vehemently defend their Denomination.

When we stand before the great white throne judgement, it will be too late. One will not be able to blame your denomination for misleading you, you had the bible (the word of GOD) and wouldn't believe it because it didn't agree with your five natural senses.

1 Corinthians 2:16* For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

1 John 2:27* But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth,

and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

The anointing that abides in you, is the same anointing Jesus was talking about when he told his deciples to tarry in Jerusalem till you be endued with power from on high.

Luke 24:49* And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

What was the main things the people took note of, their boldness and TONGUES.

1Corinthians 2:14* But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

Why do you think the scriptures say, "Turn away" from those that deny the power.

2Timothy 3:5* Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

You see why I am so insistent about following Jesus and believing ALL his word. Unfortunetly, the majority of Denomination DO NOt believe in tongues let alone the power of God working daily in their midst. Then you have the ones that believe in tongues and the power of God, BUT have compromised their standards so much that they are a joke.

You see the true church or body of Christ emerging from all denominations and gathering in what we call home bible studies. In our lukewarm society they are growing, not perfect, but growing.

<u>Hebrews 11:6*</u> But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Faith without works (acting upon it) is dead and so is Grace without faith. You see, as We have said many times, GRACE is Gods gift so as we DO NOT get what we deserve. FAITH is the means, we get what we DO deserve.

Jesus took with him to the Cross, every sin that was ever committed and also ALL sins that were to be committed. He also took every sickness or disease that ever was, and every sickness and disease that ever will be. In other words we are already healed or forgiven all it takes for us to obtain them, is faith in the Cross.

Unfortunetly, man puts more faith in Drs or man than they do the Lord. A story about a man that was diagnosed with lung cancer that the Drs said they could do nothing, they could try radiation but didn't think it would do anything. So to please his family, he had the radiation and he also had prayer. well to make a long story short, they did a C scan after and both tumors had shrunk. He was ecstatic and praised God, BUT then the Drs and his family said that, "If one set of radiation did that then more would be better. WRONG. You see, the prayer was to shrink the tumors till they disappeared and he was told this would happen and to trust God and not have anymore treatments.

He chose to trust man and in the second set of radiation, his tumors actually exhilarated in growth and he died within a year. Now I am not sharing this to discredit the Drs or him and the family, but I am trying to show the difference between trusting God compared to listening to man, The worst scenario was he would have died anyway, but then he may be alive today had he continued trusting God. Either way, he is with the lord so you see it boils down to a win, win, situation.

The point I'm trying to make is, if one chooses to trust man in our society now, what makes one think they will trust God if they miss the rapture.

The Cross and the resurrection is what makes salvation possible, by Grace are ye saved By Faith.

John 6:37* All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

Romans 10:13* For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Trust this will give you a better insight.
