--- Abundant life is Health, Peace, Joy, Financial independence and in general - Well Being.

3John 2* Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

When you draw close to the Lord and sense his presence and peace, this is the same sense of prosperity he wants in our every day life.

John 14:14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.
