#239 Who is Melchisedec

I don't know if you'll be interested, but the question of who is Melchisedec came up while studying Hebrews. So I volunteered to explain why I believe Noah and Melchisedec are one and the same.

ENOCH the man that walked with God (See Gen. 6:9 as well) had Methuselah (which means end or end of) and he was Noah's grandfather and Enoch was his great grandfather. How do you think Noah had such FAITH? Genesis 5:25-32

Noah was 500 when God told him to build the Ark in Gen. 5:32, Gen. 6:8 to 16.

it took 100 years to build the Ark (why does the religious order insist that Noah preached the coming of the flood for 120 years)

Noah was 600 when the flood came Genesis 7:6 Lamech, Noah's dad died 7 years before the flood. Gen. 5:31 Methuselah was 969 at this time and died. (end of that err-a or dispensation)

<u>Tid Bit</u>

The animals etc. came to Noah, God brought them Gen. 6:20 (he didn't go out and gather them, like man says, God did it)

The flood was 15 cubits higher than the highest mountain. *Gen.* 7:20.

The waters covered the earth 150 days Gen. 7:24 It took one year to dry up Gen 8:13

All the above is to show the genealogy and righteousness of Noah

Noah lived after the flood 350 years, his total life was 950. Now Noah was a priest before God <u>Ps 110:4</u> The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek. (Christ)

WHY was Noah a priest before God, he had exactly the same testimony from God that Enoch had, he went through the flood and started a new civilization. He was righteous through his Faith - like Abraham. He built the Ark, he obeyed God.

<u>Gen 6:9</u> Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.

Noah was a **type** of Christ, everything, including his parents, were destroyed in the flood. This was Gods NEW beginning, Noah had nothing in this new beginning, he was fatherless and motherless. In Gods analogy. Nothing existed before the flood, this was a new beginning similar to creation.

So you take the genealogy and years that coincided with Abram paying tithes to Melchisedec, Noah is the only one that fits the criteria of Melchisedec.

IF God had used another heavenly being (as most religious leaders say) then why didn't he document it? HE documented everything else, he DID however, document NOAH and NOAH was alive when Abram paid tithes

Noah was 862 when Abram was born. Gen. 11:26

Noah was about 943 when Abraham paid tithes in Gen. 14:18-20

Noah died 2 years after Ishmael was born - you add Gen. 16:16 plus Gen.11:26 and you come up with 948 years at Ishmael's birth.

In order for you to understand or agree with the linage in their life, you either have to add up the years that the bible has reference to, or take my word for it.

If you do the digging and research, it will mean more to you as the Holy Spirit will teach you. Unless of course you don't trust him and choose to trust MAN, through the various commentaries that MAN has wrote.

<u>All the scriptures referring to</u> <u>after the Order of Melchisedec</u>

<u>Ps 110:4</u> The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek. The father spoke this of the messiah - Jesus

<u>Heb 5:6</u>* As he saith also in another place, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. Again speaking of Christ

<u>Heb 5:10</u>* Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec. Again Christ

<u>Heb 6:20</u>* Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. Again Means: to live by Grace and faith

<u>Heb 7:11</u>* If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, (for under it the people received the law,) what further need was there that another priest should rise after the order of Melchisedec, and not be called after the order of Aaron?

Again means: Noah passed on his faith to his decedents as Enoch's did to him, and so also did Christ issue in the dispensation of Grace by Faith.

<u>Heb 7:17</u>^{*} For he testifieth, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. Again in Jesus we live by faith just like Noah taught his decedents, WHERE DO YOU THINK ABRAM LEARNED TO LIVE BY FAITH. (it didn't just pop out of the blue) <u>Pr 22:6</u> <u>Heb 7:21</u>* (For those priests were made without an oath; but this with an oath by him that said unto him, The Lord sware and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec:) Noah believed God ! Gen 6:9, He was perfect and walked before God. Just like Abraham, Gen 15:6 (it was counted unto him as righteousness)

GOD DID NOT CREATE ANOTHER CHRIST NOR AN ANGELIC BEING TO BE MELCHISEDEC. He used the natural MAN that we know as Noah, just like he did Abraham, Moses, Elijah and so on.
