<u>Matthew 7:8</u>* For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

<u>Luke 12:28</u>* If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more

will he clothe you, O ye of little faith.

We ask the Lord for wisdom and knowledge, then we turn to <u>MAN</u> and <u>HIS</u> writings for the answers. We read in the bible where it says, "We need not that man teach us," and also where it says, "WE have the mind of Christ." <u>1John 2:27</u>, <u>1Corinthians 2:16</u>.
