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I wish I could cover everything that pertains to these answers and give scripture reference for all. But unfortunetly they would be to long, I'm getting complaints already about the length and many do not like the scripture with it. When I first started these answers 14 years ago I really made it a matter of prayer and this is what the Holy Spirit showed me.

"Firstly Pray over the question and the answer, I will give you the words to write and the scripture to use, and try to keep it within two or three pages."

I ALWAYS do this, even with each and every Food for Thought as well.

When I am done I reread them and it NEVER ceases to amaze me, as I keep saying, "I'm not that smart to write that."

When the Lord says not to even premeditate what you're going to say but the Holy Spirit will give you what to say. <u>Mark 13:11</u> But when they shall lead you, and deliver you up,

take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost.

The Lord gave me this scripture in 1971, when he told me to go out (get my feet wet) and start sharing the Gospel. Now I took this literally, and I don't care if it's preaching, writing or just sharing in fellowship, "He" has never in 43 years failed his word to me.

I have shared all this to show you how I prayed and ask God how to show me how to deal with the few that think its to long or to much scripture.

The first thing he ask me, is were you being obedient to me and my word. My answer was YES Lord, then he said.

<u>2Timothy 3:12</u> Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus

shall suffer persecution.

Now this falls in line with your question, WHO are our enemies?

You see, I ask the Lord, why do some complain, and he said only your enemies complain, to which I said but Lord to my knowledge I don't have that many people that hate me. He ask, would people that hate you read your answers? I replied probably not, he said your enemies are good well meaning people, they are just self centered people, that put self ahead of me (God). They go by feelings and say It makes me annoyed, I know the scripture as well as he does, he makes me feel guilty.

When the Lord showed me this, all I could do was cry and say, guilty, guilty, Lord forgive me. You see I had spent (up to that time) some sixty plus years putting self ahead of God and training my family to live by their feelings (unintentionally) not actually knowing it. But once the Lord Showed me my failure I ask for his forgiveness and prayed for crop failure.

Galatians 6:7* Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for

whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

This is not something you deal with ONE time and are never again self centered, it is something you have to deal with on a daily basis. (or there about's)

<u>Luke 9:23</u>* And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

Now don't take it wrong, not everyone that disagrees with you is your enemy, if you agree on the salvation message and that Jesus is the only way, the truth and the life and that NO man cometh to the Father but by him. Then are you brothers and sisters in the Lord. <u>John 14:6</u>* I have some very dear brothers in the Lord that we do not agree on every interpretation, You see as long as it don't interfere with ones entrance to heaven, it is just window dressing.

The main reason for blocking your way to heaven is UNBELIEF, as it says in Hebrews 8.11 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Some scriptures of unbelief that will hinder your passage Heb 3:19*, Heb 4:11*, Heb 3:12

You see, under the law if you break one commandment, you broke them all.

<u>James 2:10</u>* For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.

BUT we are under Grace and the love of God, a multitude of sins is covered. <u>James 5:20</u>* Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.

So you see, it has to be a series of unbeliefs that add up to keep a soul out of Heaven, BUT it is YOU and YOU alone that chooses BELIEF or UNBELIEF.
