Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please

him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

I do not know of any christians that do not believe this, BUT there are very few that truly understand it. Faith is trusting God and believing what he said, even though you do not see the results immediately. If we do not understand something, many will run to a bible commentary and except that as Gospel. The bulk of commentaries are written by people that DO NOT believe or teach the unadulterated word of God. This eliminates them from being true, and Gods word is TRUE.

The others are written by man and even though they help explain the writings of the bible, They in no way take the place of what the Holy Spirit can and will teach you IF you do not rely on your natural senses BUT rather rely on his Spirit bearing witness with your Spirit. It is much simpler to rely on mans ways and Most choose this way.

1John 2:27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing (Holy Spirit) teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. (Trust him)

Religion has taught us that in order to witness and share the word of God, you have to be taught by man. And to a point this is true but as the scriptures say, our ways and our thoughts are way below his.

<u>Isaiah 55:8</u> For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD.

<u>Isaiah 55:9</u> For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Now there are different callings, not all are called to do the same works. But whatever you're calling, be faithful and persevere. We are ALL called of God, some to big ministries and some to individual ministries. Get your eyes OFF the big ministries and focus on YOURS. Quit trying to figure out what your ministry is, just do what God has placed within you, (if you don't look so hard), you will find it gives you peace and a measure of joy. God will or already HAS – equipped you.

Acts 13:2 (in part) the Holy Ghost said, Separate me
Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called
them.

We have all read these scriptures in Corinthians and say: "Ya BUT, God uses man."
GOD WORKS THROUGH MAN, TO CONFIRM HIS WORD A TEACHINGS.

1Corinthians 2:9-16 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

15 But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

Many say: "God don't speak to us today like he did in the bible days." You are to busy and not listening, Multitudes of Deciples and myself included will testify that is not true, some hear an audible voice, some have a vision or dream, but the majority will say, "He speaks to my heart, my soul and my spirit," and if you surrender all to him. He will speak to you anytime you will listen.

He says were friends and if you have a close friend, which one of you will only talk to them occasionally when your with them all the time?

John 15:15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.
