Rom 12.2 Do not be conformed to this world BUT be ye transformed,

Lets see what the scripture has to say about fermented wine or just plain old alcohol.

**Ge 9:20-27** Noah is the first recorded, of what alcohol will do unto you and others. (since the flood) It brought a **CURSE**, and has been ever since, look at the broken homes through alcoholism, violence, people killed and just plain old **HURT**.

<u>Pr 23:31</u> Look not thou upon the wine when it is red, when it giveth his color in the cup, when it moveth itself aright.

<u>Pr 20:1</u> Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise.

Jud 13:7 But he said unto me, Behold, thou shalt conceive, and bear a son; and now drink no wine nor strong drink, neither eat any unclean thing: for the child shall be a Nazarite to God from the womb to the day of his death.

<u>Pr 23:30</u> They that tarry long at the wine; they that go to seek mixed wine.

<u>Jas 1:27</u> Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

Joh 17:14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

3Jo 11 Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He

that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God. Ex 23:2 Thou shalt not follow a multitude to do evil; neither shalt thou speak in a cause to decline after many to wrest judgment: Joh 2:10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.

<u>Hab 2:15</u> Woe unto him that giveth his neighbour drink, that puttest thy bottle to him, and makest him drunken also, that thou mayest look on their nakedness!

Ac 2:15 For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day.

<u>2Ti 4:3</u> For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

Look at an alcoholic, they will not admit to themselves (let alone someone else), that they have a problem. They don't think it effects anyone else, yet it does effect everyone around them, especially family.
