#271 How you get extra oil

Mathew 25 1-12 This scripture is a reference in our understanding of the rapture of the church.

Virgins in the bible, is referring to Christians, five were wise and five were foolish. The lamp or light is our daily walk with the Lord (he is the light of the world, <u>John 8:12</u>, <u>Mt 5:16</u> Let your light so shine) We are to live our life so that others will see Jesus.

Oil in the bible refers to The Holy Spirit or the anointing of the Holy Spirit. Every Christian receives the Holy spirit at conversion BUT those that believe God and his word and hate evil. The Holy Spirit produces EXTRA OIL, you can't borrow it or buy it, the Holy Spirit produces it when your obedient to Gods word and doctrine.

<u>Hebrews 1:9</u> Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

You see, obedience means believing ALL of Gods word and not just the parts you can figure out with your natural (carnal) senses.

There are many, many misconceptions that are taught in the religious circles, just to name a few: Miracles ceased with what they call the last Apostle, they refuse to believe there is still Apostles in the church today.

<u>1Corinthians</u> 12:28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. & (Heb 13.8)

Nothing in Gods word changes until we are with him in Glory.

<u>1Corinthians</u> 13:9-10 For we know in part, and we prophesy in part.

But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.

Another misconception: Replacement theology, this is from the pits of Hell. Jesus was a Jew, the holy scriptures we use was written by Jews, in other words, if it wasn't for our jewish brethren, we would not have salvation.

(It does not take a rocket scientist to figure this out)

Another misconception is the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives. <u>There are three Attributes of the Holy Spirit</u>

BEFORE Salvation - He is WITH YOU,

Just as Jesus was with them in person and preached the way unto salvation, so the Holy Spirit is WITH the unsaved drawing them to Christ.

<u>John 6:44</u> No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

AT Salvation - He is IN YOU .

His presents is reveled to you or as we say, you are filled with the Holy Ghost. Now in **John 14**:16 it says he will <u>dwell with you forever</u>

<u>1Cor 3:16</u> Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

<u>John 14:16</u> And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

<u>2Cor 13:5</u> Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

AFTER Salvation - He is Upon You

This is what we call the baptism of the Holy Ghost or the anointing of God, either way, it is the power of God but it is not eternal. It is for a reason or season. To receive this anointing, you must desire or ask for it. This attribute of the Holy Spirit is ALWAYS is companied by speaking in tongues or an unknown language that God only understands. And also, you cannot have the gifts of the Holy Spirit, without first having this third attribute of the Holy Spirit.

(<u>Heb 2:4</u>* God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?) . The Holy Spirit is the Power, Fire and Oil of God.

Lu 11:13 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?

<u>Acts 1:8</u> But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

<u>Lu 24:49</u> And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Unfortunately many people will not yield to the conviction of the Holy Spirit until they see the power of the anointing.

And this is where the nine gifts of the Holy Spirit come into action and these gifts are only manifest in those that believe in the fullness of the Holy Spirit Ministry <u>1Cor 12: 8-10</u>

John 4:48 Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

The scripture says that those that deny the power of God, we are to turn away from them. Be a light and a testimony to them, but don't let them bring you down to their level.

<u>2Tim 3:5</u>* Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

The Ministry under the Law or old testament Of the Holy Spirit was, he came upon people and they were moved to prophesy or write the scriptures, make decisions, lead the people or whatever God had for them to do. King Saul is a good example, the Holy Spirit would come upon him and it also left him. Whereas under the New Covenant, we are sealed with the Holy Spirit.

<u>15a 10:10</u>, <u>15a 11:6, 1Ch 12:18, Jud 3:10</u>, <u>2Ch 15:1</u>, <u>2Ch 24:20</u>

These are just a few scriptures showing that the Holy Spirit just came upon people for a special requirement of God, whereas now, it is for ALL that ask and believe. The KEY here is BELIEVE, if you have belief and trust in God and his word, then HE will give you the extra oil to go the extra mile or two. There are 34 times in the new testament where it says, "He that believeth," and NO PLACE does it say in these scriptures you are to understand it with your carnal mind.

So you see, the extra oil talked about in Matthew 25, is obtained only by total belief in God and his word.

Some people say, "I believe this, but not this." That is the same as saying I'm a little bit pregnant, YOU EITHER ARE OR YOU AREN'T !

Remember, the five foolish virgins were waiting and watching along with the five wise virgins, but it was their UNBELIEF that kept them from entering in with the wise.

This not meant as condemnation, but a warning, Jesus is coming soon, do we have extra oil?
