

### # 310. Easy to Believe

I was ask, "Why is it so easy for you to believe Jesus and His Word" ?

I was taught by parents and grandparents that the bible was the true written word of God. You may not understand it all, but it is true and God cannot lie.

Galatians 1:20\* Now the things which I write unto you, behold, before God, I lie not.
