#312. Why Do Some Come Across As Always Right?

Jesus said:

John 13:15* For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.

As you read the bible, you will soon see and understand that Jesus never said anything the **FATHER** hadn't shown or revealed unto him first.

John 8:40* But now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God:

Luke 10:22* All things are delivered to me of my Father:

You see, what the Holy Spirit told or showed him, **HE SPOKE** or **ACTED** accordingly.

We are to tell the things we have seen with our eyes, heard with our ears and know in our heart.

Acts 4:20* For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.
