#325 But by Every Word of God.

I cannot understand just why people would sooner believe a lie or half truth over the truth. Now I realize that the bible says that in the last days, in the days of rejection of whats true and right;

2Pe 3:3* Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,

2Th 2:11* And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:

The bible teaches the truth, so the devil (through man) has made umpteen dozen new versions, supposedly so man can understand what he is reading.

That will never happen in the natural, I don't care how many translations that MAN & the Devil makes. The bible says that in the natural, it is impossible.

1Co 2:14* But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. But as we believe the bible, we walk in truth.

3Jo 4* I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.

When our Lord was tempted for 40 days by the Devil, he overcame them by quoting scripture. Now Satan quoted scripture too, but for one thing, IT WAS QUOTED WRONG, just like he does TODAY in MOST of these watered down versions today. Lu 4:4* And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.

You See, Most of these modern versions misquote or eliminate portions of scripture altogether and the carnal Christians say, "Oh well, its close enough." CLOSE only counts in the game of horse shoe.

This is one of the BIG misconceptions in the religious church today.

The other biggy, is the baptism of the Holy Ghost, MOST religious outreaches believe and teach that when you except Christ as your savior, you are baptized in the Holy Ghost. "WRONG"

Acts 19:2* He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. Do you prophesy? If not, you are not baptized with the Holy Ghost. (NO POWER)

As you read the old testament, you will find that every one the Holy Spirit came upon, prophesied.

1Sa 10:11, Ezr 5:1, Jer 26:18, and many more

In the new testament;

Ac 19:6, Lu 1:67, and throughout the book of acts

Another misconception or out right lie, is that the Magi or wise men came to Bethlehem's manger at Jesus birth, another LIE, it was almost two years later and they went to Nazareth. Luke 2:1-32

Luke 2:22* And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present him to the Lord;

(Jesus was 40 days old here)

24* And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.

(they were poor, they hadn't received the wise mens gift yet, they could not afford a more expensive offering so went the cheapest way the law would permit) "Look it up"

Matthew 2:9-18 The wise men came to Jerusalem , and Herod told them to go to Bethlehem but when they came away from Herod, The star appeared before them and they followed the star to Nazareth and went into the house (not stable) where they found the young child (NOT BABY) and presented their gifts of Gold, Frankincense and Myrrh. This was to provide Joseph & Mary enough finances to flee to Egypt for a few years. WE KNOW BY THE SCRIPTURES THAT JESUS WAS OLDER THAN 40 DAYS AND YOUNGER THAN 2 YEARS. Because Herod sent the solders to Bethlehem to kill all male children under two years old.

Matt 2:8* And he sent them to Bethlehem, and said, Go and search diligently for the young child; and when ye have found him, bring me word again, that I may come and worship him also.

11* And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.

12* And being warned of God in a dream that they should not return to Herod, they departed into their own country another way.

13* ¶ And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord **appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt,** and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.

14 When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt:

23* And **he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth**: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets, He shall be called a Nazarene.

Now this is only one instance, there is in earth compared to mans on earth, there is pricked in the heart compared to mans cut to the heart. Go to
