# 327 Is There Two Gospels One for the Jew and One For the Gentile

God forbid, definitely no, there were those of the traditional converts that told the Gentiles, "You have to be circumcised and keep the law," but the Holy Ghost and the Apostles answer is recorded in Acts 15.

Acts 15:24 Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment:

Acts 15:28\29 For it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things;

That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well. But carnal man, have been changing the gospel ever since, first came the divisions (Denominations).

But thank God, he had the Apostle Paul to stand for the gospel. 1Cor 3:3\10 It didn't take Satan long to divide the deciples or Christians into differences of opinion, these are the seven churches in Asia, recorded in Revelation.
