When a person firmly believes that Jesus died on the cross for that person only! And therefore they are forgiven for all they do wrong including breaking commandments, what is that sin?

First of all, **It is GOOD** when one realizes that Christ died for them personally.

The old, world religions have painted a picture you are no body special, that God is not concerned on a personal basis but rather a group basis. This is totally wrong, he loves us each separately but he also loves us **ALL THE SAME.** Until we have a personal relationship with Jesus, **WE HAVE NOTHING.**

John 3:16* For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

But there are some that adhere to the Doctrine **ONCE SAVED ALWAYS SAVED:** this is also totally wrong.

Romans 3:23* For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

1John 1:8* If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. We are in the **FLESH**, and unfortunately, until we get our heavenly glorified body, our flesh or the old man (sinful nature) **WILL** resurrect itself from time to time and when it does we will feel convicted and all we have to do, is say Lord, I'm sorry (and mean it). 1John 1:9* If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Galatians 2:20* I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

2Corinthians 5:15* And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again.

You see, We have a choice, we can try our best to walk with God **OR** we can listen to the evil spirits and these whitewashed false doctrines. One leads to eternal life, with our Lord, the other leads to eternal life **WITHOUT** the Lord.

Romans 6:23* For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
