

Follow up for Sat. Or Sun.

Jesus the Son of God, the Messiah came to earth about 2000 years ago, to fulfill the promise of God the father, in **Genesis 3:14 & 15**.

The Law was introduced **THROUGH** Moses in **Exodus**, the dispensation of Grace through faith in Jesus was issued in around 30 A.D. Jesus said

Mt 5:17* Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to **fulfill**.

NOT DO AWAY WITH but **FULFILL**, it is similar to have a bunch of dirty dishes that need to be cleaned and you decide to wash them. You didn't destroy them, you washed them and made them clean, ready for use.

Just the 10 commandments is not the whole law, like the modern day commandment keepers think and proclaim. Read the whole book of Exodus!! These people say you have to keep the Sabbath (thats law) and the rest is under Grace.

the bible says **Jas 2:10*** For whosoever shall **keep the whole law**, and yet **offend in one point**, he is guilty of all.

The bible also says; **Col 2:16*** **Let no man** therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, **or of the sabbath days**:

Ga 6:2* Bear ye one another's burdens, **and so fulfill the law of Christ**.

What is the law of Christ, as I have said before he quoted the first two of the 10 commandments: Love the Lord with all your heart and mind, the second is Love your neighbor as yourself and the third is to love those in Christ Jesus as Jesus Loves us, (that is **UNCONDITIONALLY**). (Mt 22:37\40)

Joh 14:15* **If ye love** me, keep my commandments.

So you see, Jesus's commandments are **LOVE**.

1Co 13:2* And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and **have not charity or LOVE**, I am nothing.

What makes it sin, is those that say; you must keep Saturday as the Sabbath, this is **WORKS** not Grace, the Law is **ALL works**. The bible says; **by Grace are ye saved**, through faith and **not of works** lest any man should boast.

As I said, the Holy Spirit new the Sabbath was going to be a stumbling block so he had the disciples choose the first church day of worship to be the **FIRST** day of the week because the savior of mankind rose from the dead on the **FIRST** day of the week and Jesus also said, seek ye **FIRST** the kingdom of God and his righteousness. (**Mt 6:33**)

He also asks for our **FIRST** fruits. Do you get the connection?

In the late 1700s there are two popular religious orders formed that are not what the Apostles taught but there is quite a similarity. So it is not for us to play Holy Spirit, that is his job. The bible says in **Ga 1:8*** But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach **any other gospel** unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

And Jesus himself says to the disciples in; **Mr 9:38\40** as long as they're following the plan of salvation (preaching Jesus, his death and resurrection) then they can't be to far wrong. But the one thing that bothers me with some of their leaders, is that in what they figure is a private meeting, they have voiced that the Sunday people won't get into heaven because they have ignored Saturday. I shared with you that it was the 12 Apostles and the Holy Spirit that chose the first day of the week and **NOT** Catholicism as they declare. And as I said, it was the Apostles that verified to the gentile church that under Jesus we are no longer under the law. (Acts 15:24)

Ro 6:14* For sin shall not have dominion over you: for **ye are not under** the law, but under grace.

Ga 5:18* But if ye be led of the Spirit, **ye are not under** the law.

The problem with most of all these modern religions is that in order to be led by the Spirit you must be baptized with the Holy Spirit. This is not the Spirit you receive at salvation or when you are baptized into Christ (this is **IN you**), the day of Pentecost the Holy Spirit came **UPON** them. Most of the anointed preachers I know and have heard, are from Baptist, Lutheran, Catholic or Evangelic churches that have been baptized with the Holy Spirit and now speak in an unknown language or **TONGUES**, the very thing they once preached against.

Speaking in the Spirit, **DOES NOT** make you a better christian, it is part of the armor of god, it is for your benefit, he is the **POWER OF GOD**.

Ac 1:8* But **ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you**: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Joh 16:13* Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, **he will guide** you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. You will find that those that keep the law or keep part of it, **DO NOT** believe in the baptism of the Holy Ghost with speaking in tongues, but those that didn't believe and were baptized, will tell you what was missing in their life before.

Ac 7:51* Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always **resist the Holy Ghost**: as your fathers did, so do ye.

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
