

What is The Extra Oil

Mat 25:3 They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:

Oil in the old testament, it always refers to the anointing of the Holy Spirit, Kings and Prophets and people called of God were anointed with oil.

1Sa 10:1 Then Samuel took a vial of oil, and poured it upon his head, (**Saul**) and kissed him, and said, Is it not because the LORD hath anointed thee to be captain over his inheritance?

1Sa 10:6 And the Spirit of the LORD will come upon thee, and thou shalt prophesy with them, and shalt be turned into another man.

1Sa 16:13 Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon **David** from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

1Ki 1:39 And Zadok the priest took an horn of oil out of the tabernacle, and anointed **Solomon**. And they blew the trumpet; and all the people said, God save king Solomon.

But they were not sealed with the Holy Spirit like we are under the NEW covenant. We read that after Saul disobeyed God the Spirit lifted from him.

The Greek word for baptized (**baptw**) or baptism **baptisma** means a dipping, emersion or sinking.

Baptized was invented by the KJV, because the practice of sprinkling babies was practiced by the church of England and the Catholic church, seeing, that you could not immerse an infant without a possible drowning, they invented sprinkling. NOW this not only changes the word of God as to performance, but you have to be old enough to know you need a savior. Not only that, NOBODY can believe for someone else, you can pray that God will help them realize that they need a savior once their old enough to understand, we are saved by grace through faith and NOT OF WORKS. Water dunking does not save you, that works, the Only way to have eternal life in Heaven, is to believe and except what Jesus said --- **John 14:6*** Jesus saith unto him, **I am the way**, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Now the bible says, **Mr 16:16*** **He that believeth and is** baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

But as you read and study the scriptures, you'll find that this has no reference to water BUT is referring to the instant of salvation when the Holy Spirit baptizes you into Jesus. Remember the thief on the cross, he was not water baptized and yet Jesus said, THIS DAY you will be with me in paradise. YOU SEE, he was baptized into Christ the second he said, Lord remember me.

As you prayerfully read and study the scriptures, you will find that there are actually three baptisms taught #1 time of salvation when the Holy Spirit baptizes you into Christ.

The other two are not in any particular order, #2 water baptism in obedience to Gods word, where your old man or old nature is supposed to die and be buried, few truly understand that. And #3, baptized with the Holy Ghost, this is when Jesus baptizes you into the Holy Ghost, this is the extra oil that the five wise virgins have.

Lu 24:49* And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but **tarry ye** in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Joh 1:33* And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see **the Spirit descending**, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.

Now a lot of evangelical Christians will follow so far, BUT you mention the word speaking in tongues and most of them will run NO MATTER what the Apostle Paul says about tongues. The Holy Spirit is the spirit of truth, **Joh 14:17*** Even the **Spirit of truth**; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

The reason the world or ungodly cannot receive him is because **Heb 11:6*** But **without faith** it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
