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The first Philadelphia Lawyer was Satan, in the garden of Eden. He tempted Eve with. "Has God really said, you shall not surely die!"

Ge 3:1 hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

Ge 3:4 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:

He spoke a very partial truth, but he accomplished what he wanted, and that was to question **AUTHORITY** and in this case, **GODS** authority.

He has been doing this (through man) ever since, **WHY** do you think we have so many so called Christian denominations, and thousands upon thousands of Laws on the books today?

<u>Ga 3:27</u>* For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. (this is the first baptism)

Heb 3:7* Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice),

THIS IS WHEN JESUS LIVES WITHIN US AND OUR BODIES BECOME THE TEMPLE OF THE HOLY GHOST.

1Co 3:16* Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

Again, the majority of professing christens **DO NOT** believe this.

The second baptism is water baptism, and the third, is when Jesus baptizes us in the Holy Ghost.

<u>Lu 3:16</u>* John answered, saying unto them all, <u>I indeed baptize</u> you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

We have a multitude of Christians that are born again, and when they die, they **WILL** go to heaven, but in this life, they have no power.

To preach the gospel, all you need is to be born again, **BUT** to do signs and wonders, you need the baptism of the Holy Ghost.

Ac 1:8* But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Do You Have This Power?

<u>Ac 3:6</u>* Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

The point I'm trying to make is that the majority of society has the mentality of a Philadelphia Lawyer in other words they can only think with the natural mind. They do not have nor believe in the baptism and power of the Holy Ghost So they have no spiritual mind. and what does the bible say about that? Ro 8:6* For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.
