
Hebrews 9:27* And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

When this body dies, our eternal soul either goes to Heaven to be with Jesus, **OR** Hell (a place prepared for the devil and his angels) to spend eternity in torment.

Read Luke 16:22 to 31, 22&23 And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried;

<u>23</u>* And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.

But we who are saved by the grace of God, and are submersed in water (baptized) **AFTER** we believed (or are saved), are now buried with Christ. Our old sinful nature is dead and buried and the second death (when the physical body dies and then stand at the judgement seat of Christ (no sinners here) or we stand at the **GREAT** white throne judgement).

Romans 6:3-5 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?

<u>4</u>* Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

 $\underline{5}^*$ For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:

Man with his pea sized mind, has been trying to change the meaning of the bible to fit their own understanding ever since the scriptures was written

<u>Matthew 21:25</u> The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then believe him?

The word for baptize is, baptizw baptizo; which means to dip, sink:or submerge.

YOU see, the lustrous priesthood didn't believe Jesus back then, and it's the priesthood that have brought all these damnable heresies and traditions of man into the church of Jesus Christ, today its even worse. Even the Evangelic believers call what they do not understand, "It is of the devil" !!!!!

You see, Jesus said; <u>John 10:28</u>* And I give unto them <u>eternal life</u>; and they shall never <u>perish</u>, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

So why fear death, we have eternal life **NOW** and don't have to wait for the sweet bye & bye. **TRUE** the body **WILL DIE**, but **OUR** soul and spirit just moves from this physical body, to live with Jesus.

Hebrews 9:27* And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

The judgment: is what we worry about, **BUT**, if you have excepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior in the here and now, you have nothing to worry about in the hereafter.

The word of God talks of **BAPTISMS** (this is plural) and in Hebrews 6:2 Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

Baptisms, is plural, meaning more than one. As a matter of fact there are three, Salvation or The Holy Ghost baptizes you into Christ, Water baptism, where your put under the water, symbolizing the old man or nature is dead and buried with Christ. **SO YOU SEE**, the second death has no bearing on you, you died and was buried at baptism. **THE THIRD** baptism is when you receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost, or in other words, when the Holy Ghost comes upon you, the sign being, **SPEAKING IN A HEAVENLY LANGUAGE.**

Mark 16:16* He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

MOST fellowships believe this is the baptism of the Holy Ghost, **NOT SO**, it is when the Holy Ghost baptizes you into **CHRIST** (salvation).

John said; <u>Matthew 3:11</u>* I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he (Jesus) shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

The result is, the day of Pentecost. And as the fire of God fell on the first animal sacrifice for sin atonement, the fire from God started it. So it was at Pentecost, the cloven tongues of fire started the heavenly language
