John 16.7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. And Acts 1:4,5&8 And Luke 24:49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Jesus needed the Holy Spirit; Mark 1:10-11.

And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him: And there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

John the baptized was told by God that when he seen the Holy Spirit descend and STAY upon, was the Son of God and HE was the one that would baptize (immures) with the Holy Ghost and POWER.

John 1:32-33. And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.

And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.

The reason for sharing the STAYING ON part, is because in the old testament, the Holy spirit would come upon people and they would prophesy and do extra ordinary things, But he would not stay upon them indefinitely. King Saul was a good example, the Holy Spirit came upon him and he prophesied, BUT he also left him. (1sam 10:10 & 1sam 16:14) . In the new testament we are sealed once and forever, after the Holy Ghost comes upon you. (2Cor 1:22)
