Oil in the bible refers to the Holy Spirit.

Exodus 37:29 And he made the holy anointing oil, The Holy anointing oil is mentioned 20 times in the old testament and Saul was Anointed to be King. So David was anointed king.

15amuel 10:1 Then Samuel took a vial of oil, and poured it upon his head, and kissed him, and said, Is it not because the LORD hath anointed thee to be captain over his inheritance?

ISamuel 16:13 Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

There are many other scriptures that refer to the anointing relating to the anointing of the Holy Spirit. The bible also records that those that did not follow God, they lost the anointing, like King Saul.

15amuel 18:10 And it came to pass on the morrow, that the evil spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied in the midst of the house: and David played with his hand, as at other times: and there was a javelin in Saul's hand.

In Hebrews it talks about those that serve righteousness will be anointed with the oil of gladness above the others.

Hebrews 1:9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

This anointing, ABOVE the OTHERS refers to what the book of Acts is full of. (refer to #21 the three attributes of the Holy Spirit on our web, under Answers) Our website is christiancrusades.ca

Now in the book of Acts the sign is always they spoke with other tongues. In our American society, this is foolishness and is explained away and thus there is little or no signs and wonders accruing in our weekly gatherings. NOW THIS

3rd attribute of the Holy Spirit, does not make you better, **it equips you better**.

Jude 20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, (tongues)

Romans 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself machete intercession for us with groaning which cannot be uttered. (tongues) Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, (tongues)

Now this is not my word, but God's word, you can try to explain it away, but it still will be the truth and won't change.

It's like the majority of our society, unmarried but living together.

They rationalize that God is a forgiven God and yes that's true. BUT forgiveness requires repentance, in other words, **quit doing what you ask forgiveness for.**

Revelation 21:8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.
