

Why prayer

**Matthew 16:19** And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

**Matthew 7:7** Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

**Genesis 1:26** And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

**Luke 9:1** Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

In (Matthew 16:19) He says, I give you the keys to the kingdom of Heaven. If you have the keys to a house, car or whatever. You have the authority to use whatever that commodity has to offer. Such as the powers of Heaven.;

(Luke 9-1, Mark 16:17, Mark 10:42, )

You say, what is Fervent Prayer

fervent prayer - impassioned, passionate, intense, vehement, ardent, sincere, fervid, heartfelt; enthusiastic, zealous, fanatical, hardcore, wholehearted, avid, eager, keen, committed, dedicated, devout

In other words, you mean business, not something wishy washy.

BUT the fervent prayer, or praying through, in other words, you know that you know, HE answered or the answer is on the way. Many people pray and pray and are not really sure that it will accomplish much.

**BUT fervent or praying through, you have no doubt. Then it is a matter of thanking God every time you remember that need you were praying for. (Matthew 8:8 is a good example)**

**PRAYER: is SPEAKING to God as we would to another person (with respect, yet boldness). Or commanding demons and sickness to leave or speaking in Jesus Name, to circumstances. (with authority and assurance)**

**Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.**
