### How do you live a Victorious Christian life ?

#### Jesus said:

Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest

Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. John 10:9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. Revelation 22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

These are just a few scriptures amid multitudes, that Jesus say's will give you salvation and life everlasting, through His shed blood on Calvary's cross.

Romans 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

There is no place in the scriptures where it says you have to clean your sinful nature up, before you can come to Christ. On the contrary, he says ALL YE that LABOUR and are HEAVY laden, And WHOSOEVER will.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. You see, we can not clean up or change ourselves without Christ. Once we come to Christ just as we are, HE will start to clean us up, according to HIS priorities.

Not ours or our well meaning friends. He does it such a way, that we no longer desire to do the things that are against his will.

You say, what is his will ?

John 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments. Jesus gave us Two commandments in the new covenant.

Matthew 22:37/40 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

38 This is the **first** and great commandment.

39\* And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself.

40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

It all boils down to LOVE, IF YOU LET LOVE Rule your life, then there is forgiveness. Unforgiveness is one of the most frequent and most prevalent sins committed in the body of Christ.

He has given us promises and the ability to rise above the everyday trials and temptations that we encounter.

But these promises require us to do something, we must lay claim to them and by faith confess them, even if we only see it in the future.

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

One of the first promises he makes is:

Matthew 11:29/30 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

## **Peace and Rest**

The first is to learn of him, **Hows that ?** By reading and listening to his written word, the bible. THEN he promises, we will find REST or peace unto our souls.

This is one thing the world don't have, is inner peace, with the inner peace of Jesus there is no stress that plaques the world today.

But you have to claim the peace (in Jesus name) Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

## Healing and confession

1John 1:9 **If we confess our sins**, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Psalms 103:3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

You see we can live in divine health by claiming and confessing his promises. Most sicknesses is due to the devil or sin.

Unconfessed sin allows satan to have legal right to your well being, ask God to search out your soul.

Psalms 139:23 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:

Psalms 139:24 And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

God will show you any unconfessed sin if you ask him.

# What you confess with your mouth

If you say, I think I'm coming down with a cold or the flu, You Had Better Believe You Will.

**BUT** when you feel something coming, you rebuke it in Jesus name, take authority over satan and sickness and then quote and confess the appropriate scriptures.

example Isaiah 53:5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Psalm 91:10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

John 16:23-24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

John 14:13-15 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

If ye love me, keep my commandments.

Just remember Jesus is the vine and we are the branches, all that we have comes from him.

Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Matthew 6:26-32 as well

Don't be led astray by those that emphasize money as the main reward from God.

1Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

He multiplied the loaves and fishes, the Israelites clothes never wore out in the wilderness.

Deuteronomy 8:4 Thy raiment waxed not old upon thee, neither did thy foot swell, these forty years.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday today and forever.

Malachi 3:6 For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

#### All it takes to live a victorious Christian life, is to believe and trust God and his word Then lay claim to his promises.

Matthew 7:7-8 Ask, and it shall be given you; (this means what it says, ask the Lord) seek, and ye shall find; (search the scriptures and find his promises) knock, and it shall be opened unto you: (rebuke the devil and quote the promises you found until you get the results)

For every one that asketh **receiveth**; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.
